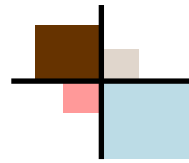

Congregational Health Nursing is defined as a "unique, specialized practice of professional nursing which focused on the promotion of health within the context of the values, belief and practice of a faith community"

BASIC PREPARATION FOR CONGREGATIONAL HEALTH NURSES

This course is offered through a cooperative relationship between the Mississippi College School of Nursing in Clinton, MS, Abundant Living Community Organization (ALCO), and Baptist Health Systems, Inc.. This course is based on the endorsed curriculum for parish nurse education published by the International Parish Nurse Resource Center. The parish nurse role is a health-promotion, risk-reduction, disease-prevention nursing role that focuses on care of the whole person, holding the spiritual dimensions to be central to the practice.

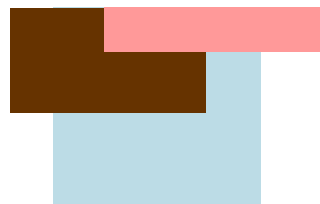
